

## Method 13-b

## Black Wildebeest (White-Tailed Gnu)

**Length:** Using a carpenter's square, find right angle **(XYZ)** along the boss. Line **(XY)** is parallel to the center line of the skull. Line **(YZ)** is at a right angle to the axis of the skull and will touch the lowest point of the boss. Bisect **(XYZ)** at 45 degrees **(M)**. The starting point for measuring the length is **(A)**. Next, mark the lowest points on the "elbow" of the horns before they curve up **(B)**. Start at **A,** follow the grain of the horn over the ridge of the boss to the front of the horn, go over lowest point, and then move up the front to the tip. **(L)** 

**Width:** Measure the boss at its widest point. Place the tape where the horn meets the skull in the front and go over the highest point of the boss to the back; stop measuring when the horn ends and the skull re-appears. **(W)** This is NOT a circumference measurement.

**Tip-to-Tip Spread:** Measure the tip-to-tip spread. **(E)**
